In the face of the unimaginable horrors unfolding in Lebanon, where relentless Israeli attacks have claimed the lives of over **560 innocent souls** and left more than **1,600 wounded**, we find ourselves on the brink of a humanitarian catastrophe. Entire villages in Southern Lebanon and Bequa' area have been shattered, and just yesterday, more than 26,000 people, families who once knew the comfort of home, were forced to flee amid the relentless barrage of fire. Many, including children and the elderly, did not survive the desperate attempt to escape. The scale of this tragedy is beyond comprehension, and each passing moment brings only more suffering. Now, more than ever, we turn to you. Your urgent support is not just needed; it is a lifeline. With every moment, the situation grows direr, and your swift action is crucial in helping us secure the supplies and care that these vulnerable people so desperately need. The time to act is now, before the devastation deepens, and more lives are lost.

Beit Atfal Assumoud remains unwavering in its commitment to providing vital assistance to all displaced individuals from Lebanese villages and Palestinian camps. Our ongoing relief efforts focus on distributing **food parcels and hygiene kits** to displaced families, many of whom are now scattered across various Palestinian camps all over Lebanon.

Emergency Required Needs

• Hygiene Kits

Hygiene kits are of utmost importance, especially given that many displaced families are now living together in their relative's homes within the Palestinian camps. Maintaining proper hygiene in such conditions is critical to preventing the spread of illness and ensuring the well-being of these vulnerable populations.

• Contents of the Hygiene Kits:

• Food Parcels

Beit Atfal Assumoud will be providing daily food parcels to displaced families who have fled from their homes seeking shelter with relatives and extended families in all Palestinian camps. This initiative aims to support those impacted by the crisis by addressing their immediate nutritional needs during this challenging time. Our team in each camp will be visiting these families to personally deliver the food parcels, ensuring they feel supported and not like a burden to their host families. This approach is designed to provide relief and show solidarity during this difficult time.
